Since 1998 **Dr.** Cheryl White has been with LSU-Shreveport. She is a professor of history in the College of Arts and Sciences. She is the author of several books on local and regional history as well as journal articles in the field of medieval and early modern preservation efforts.

Dr. White holds the Hubert Humphreys Endowed Professorship in History and is active in local historic preservations efforts, serving as the academic coordinator for the Spring Street Museum.


