Shreveport Green was founded in 1990 as a joint project of the Shreveport Beautification Foundation and the Shreveport Clean Community Commission, with much of the initial support and encouragement coming from the Shreveport Medical Society.

Currently, Shreveport Green is governed by a board of 24 directors, with the implementation of projects being carried out by a full time staff of four.

Visitation will be on Tuesday, September 8 from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at Osborn Funeral Home. A memorial service will be held on Wednesday, September 9 at 1:30 p.m. at St. Mark's Cathedral.

Jeff joined our club in 1996 and was sponsored by his father, Judge James Clark, who was club president at the time. Jeff was a PHF+4 and was a club director in 2014-2015.

Our District Grant

Each year our current club president selects a local non-profit project and applies for a grant from Rotary District 6190 to help with funding.

This year President Laurie Boswell selected the **Betty and Leonard Phillips Deaf Action Center of Louisiana**. During this year the Deaf Action Center will produce a series of six videos in American Sign Language on the following topics: What is Diabetes, Thriving With Diabetes, Nutrition and Diabetes, Fitness and Diabetes, Medications and Diabetes and Info for Medical Professionals.

These videos will be broadcast on the Center's internet television channel (www.ampchannel.tv) and will be made available to over 4,000 deaf and hard of hearing people in North Louisiana and, by virtue of the internet, to an unlimited number of persons in the United States.

Coupled with the \$2,000 grant from Rotary District 6190 and an equal \$2,000 match from our club, we are able to partner with the Deaf Action Center to produce these videos.

The District funds are developed through our donations to The Rotary Foundation as a percentage of our donations are returned to the district for the funding of grants to the clubs. Our club's match is developed through our dues process.

This is just one of the many ways that our club is making an impact locally!


